Montreal, July 7th, 2021 – The National Congress of Italian-Canadians is delighted to organise once more this year the art competition *Il Piccolo Leonardo* as part of the events that will be held in the 28th edition of Montreal's Italian Week festival. Young artists are invited to give free rein to their creativity in the realization of a drawing, a painting or other work of art, taking inspiration from the wonders of Italy to show what they represent to them. Art thus becomes an excellent opportunity to introduce them to the richness and beauty of the Italian culture.

The competition is divided into three categories of participants: 4 to 6 years old, 7 to 9 years old, and 10 to 12 years old. Participants can send a photo of their completed work by email to piccololeonardo@semaineitalienne.ca. A winner will be selected for each category and one overall winner will be chosen among all of the participants. At the end of the contest, the winners will have to send their work to the following address for a future collective exhibition: National Congress of Italian-Canadians at 8370 boul. Lacordaire, Suite 302, Saint-Léonard, H1R 3Y6. The announcement of the winners will be made on the festival's social media (date and hour to be confirmed).

The deadline to submit an artwork is July 20, 2021.

Young artists are invited to create a work of art inspired by the wonders of Italy and what it represents in their eyes.

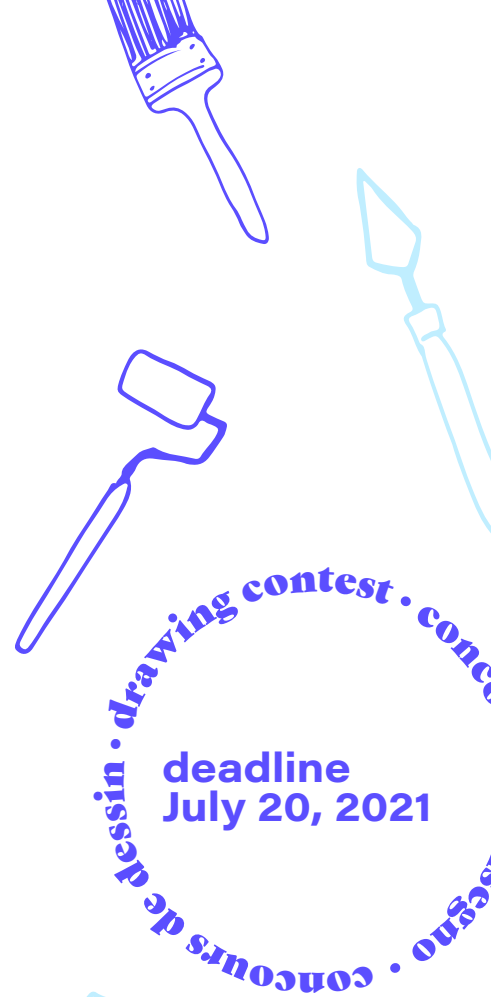
The competition will be divided into three categories: 4-6, 7-9 and 10-12 years old. A prize will be awarded for each category as well as a prize for the big winner of the contest.

rules of the contest

1. The works can be carried out on a sheet of drawing paper or a canvas;
2. The materials and techniques used in carrying out the works are up to the artist to decide;
3. Considering the current situation of COVID-19, works must be submitted by email to piccololeonardo@semaineitalienne.ca by July 20, 2021;
4. The following information must be included in the email:
 - Title of the work
 - First and last name of the artist
 - Age of the artist
 - Postal address of the artist
 - E-mail address and phone number
 - Name of the school, organization or association

** All the drawings with missing information will be excluded from the contest.*
5. We do not accept traced artwork or designs already made;
6. The works will be selected and evaluated by a jury composed of professional artists. At the end of the contest, the winners shall bring their works of art to the address below for a future collective exhibition:
